

**Additional Materials for Hack:**

10 " Separating Zipper

**Creating the Starburst:**

Complete all of the steps in this section from the original pattern.

**Finishing the Starburst Flap:**

1. Complete steps 1-3 in this section from the original pattern.
2. Clip corners, flip right side out and press.
3. Fold the raw edge of the top ½" inwards and press.
4. Separate the 10" zipper. *NOTE: We used the half of the zipper that did not have the pull.*



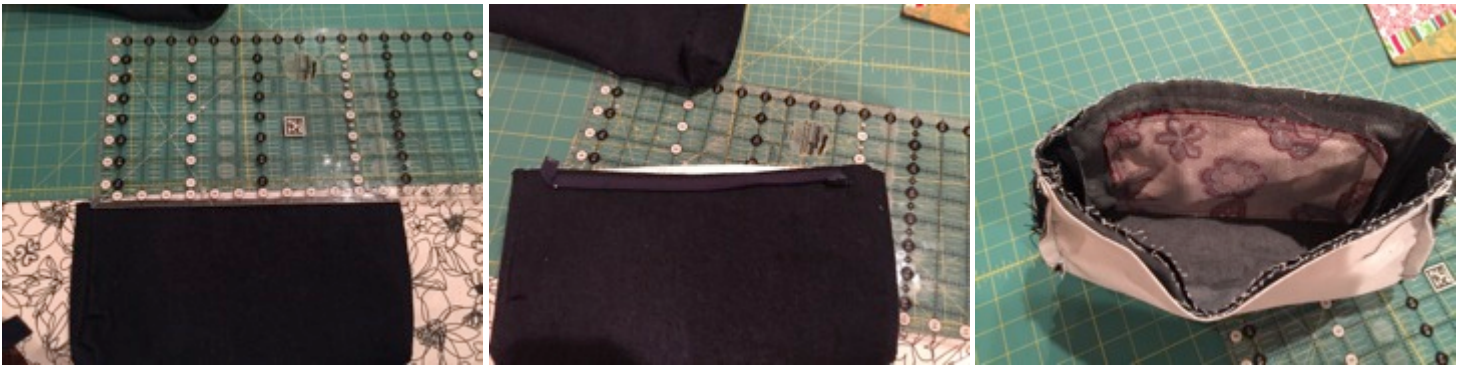
5. Fold the end of the zipper tape by the top stopper 90 degrees behind and away from zipper teeth and press. Center zipper on the flap with right side up and teeth away from flap. Insert the zipper tape inside the top of the flap leaving about ⅛" of zipper tape exposed and pin.
6. Topstitch around the entire flap to close the opening and attach the zipper.

**Adding Inside Zipper Pocket to the Lining:**

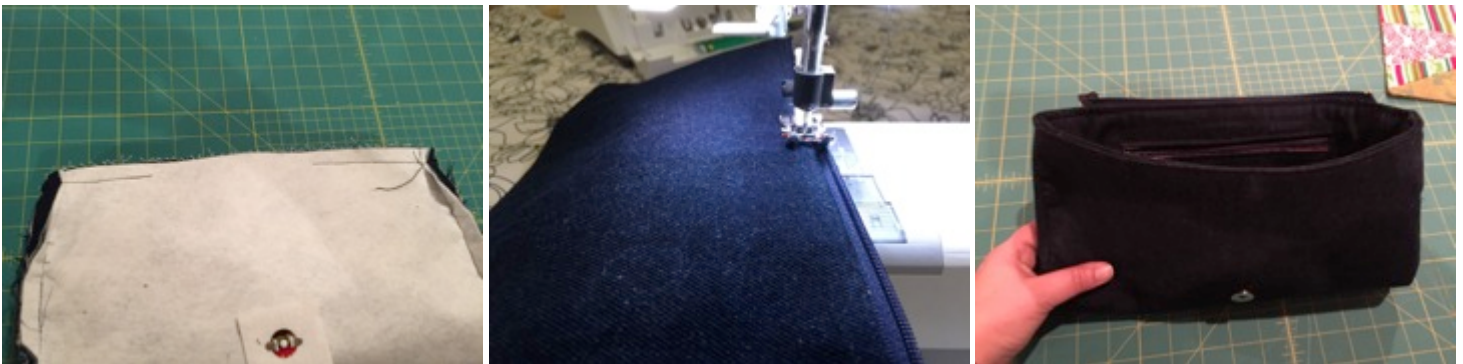
Complete all of the steps in this section from the original pattern.

**Completing the Bag:**

1. Complete steps 1-7 in this section from the original pattern.
2. Flip Outer Bag right side out.
3. Fold the end of the zipper tape by the top stopper 90 degrees behind and away from zipper teeth and press. Center zipper on the back of the Outer Bag with right sides together and teeth side down. Drop the edge of the zipper tape ¼" from the raw edge of the Outer Bag and baste.
4. Flip Outer Bag inside out.
5. With Lining right side out, and Outer Bag inside out, put Lining inside the Outer Bag, matching side seams.



6. Sew together, leaving a 6" opening in the front to flip. Turn the bag right side out by pulling it through the 6" opening.
7. Push Lining inside the bag, folding the Lining and the Outer Bag 1/2" inward along the opening in the front, press and pin closed. Continue pressing along the top edge so that the Lining is all to the inside of the bag. You may need to use steam.
8. Topstitch a scant 1/4" around entire bag.
9. Match side seam to side seam to create a fold going towards the inside of the bag and press using steam. This will help keep the sides of the bag from pushing out.



10. Zip on your completed flap and we're done!



You can make as many interchangeable flaps as you like! All you need is a 10" separating zipper, the male end of a magnetic snap, fun fabric scraps for the flap and a 20" X 15" scrap of batting!!
